### April 25, 2026 – SATURDAY

#### PRAGUE

- **arrival in Prague** - an ancient European city renowned for its beauty and unique wealth of historical sights, the capital of the Czech Republic . Prague lies in the very heart of Bohemia. The town - originally founded in the 10<sup>th</sup> century on the banks of the Vltava River is often called „golden „, or „hundredspired“. It is the real treasury of arts and architecture of all styles.

### April 26, 2026 – SUNDAY

#### PRAGUE

- **halfday city tour of Prague /duration 4 hours/** - explore the capital of the Czech Republic during sightseeing tour of Prague and visit the Prague Castle with famous St. Vitus Cathedral, picturesque Golden Lane and Gothic Vladislav Hall , continue to the historical Lesser Town area and finish the tour in the Old Town of Prague

### April 27, 2026 – MONDAY

#### PRAGUE

- **walking tour of the Old Town of Prague /duration 3 hours/** -passing the Old Town Square with famous astronomical clock, continue to the former Jewish Ghetto of Prague with Jewish cemetery and several Jewish synagogues and walk across the Charles Bridge overlooking the panorama of the Prague Castle

**April 28,2026 – TUESDAY**

**PRAGUE-CESKY KRUMLOV-PRAGUE**

- buffet-breakfast at the hotel
- fullday excursion to Cesky Krumlov - visit the historical town reserve preserved by UNESCO in Southern Bohemia . This small medieval town, almost unchanged since the 18<sup>th</sup> century, is one of the most picturesque in Europe. Krumlov Castle is the second largest fortification in the Czech Republic after Prague Castle and certainly one of the oldest. The most ancient part is the round tower dating from the second half of the 13<sup>th</sup> century. Walk through narrow streets in the town centre and visit to the Krumlov castle, lunch included.
- return to Prague in the late afternoon
- overnight in Prague



**April 29,2026 – WEDNESDAY**

**PRAGUE-CESKY KRUMLOV-PRAGUE**

- buffet-breakfast at the hotel
- day at leisure in Prague
- evening 2-hour cruise on the Vltava River with buffet-dinner
- overnight in Prague



**April 30, 2026 – THURSDAY**

**PRAGUE-KARLOVY VARY**

- travel from Prague to Karlovy Vary - drive out of Prague and through the picturesque West Bohemian countryside to the city of Karlovy Vary. This world-famous spa has become famous for its 12 natural medicinal mineral springs, from which you will have the opportunity to taste, but is best known for its "Vřídlo" (Geyser), expelling its curative water up to a height of 12 m. The city has also reached worldwide acclaim for the Karlovy Vary International Film Festival held annually.

- walking tour of Karlovy Vary spa resort with local guide
- overnight in Karlovy Vary
